



Rugby Bowmen

Rugby Bowmen are keen to encourage archers to develop their archery skills so we have adopted, the 252 awards scheme.

The 252 awards scheme is designed to help you practice your shooting at different distances and reward your achievements.

How it works

Shooting on a 122cm face at distances 20,30,40,50,60 yards you score as follows

Gold=9 Red=7 Blue=5 Black=3 White=1

After 6 practice shots (sighters) you continue with 36 scoring arrows the aim is as it suggests to score 252 or over, do this twice consecutively and you can claim your award. Different scores are available for different classes of bow, detailed in the table below.

Awards must be claimed in sequence ie, 20.30.40 etc,

To make a claim, two scores must be recorded on a club score card witnessed and presented to the records officer.

Bow types

Recurve: Olympic Recurve, button, rest, sight, stabiliser, clicker

Barebow: Olympic Recurve type bow, no sight, stabiliser or clicker

Longbow: Any wooden bow shot off the shelf, without a separate arrow rest
